2021 PNM American Indian Summer Engineering Internship Program

(ALBUQUERQUE, NM) – PNM, New Mexico’s largest energy provider, is proud to announce paid summer college engineering internships for American Indian students in the greater Albuquerque area.

PNM will fill three temporary internship positions. Interns will perform assignments designed to enhance engineering knowledge and abilities, including basic engineering support on operational and customer-related engineering projects.

This internship will provide participants an opportunity to work with company executives and other stakeholders to represent Native American interests affecting the utility industry. The interns will also provide support to the Director of Tribal Government & Customer Engagement, by participating in business meetings with tribal leaders, department staff and company management.

“The PNM American Indian Summer Internship Program underscores our ongoing commitment to job creation and workforce training and is a key component of the PNM’s Tribal Customer Engagement Program,” said Cathy Newby, Director of Tribal Government and Customer Engagement for PNM. Now in its eleventh year, 31 students have completed the summer engineering internship with PNM that has provided value career experience. The internship program has also resulted in the hiring of five interns into a full-time Engineering positions with PNM.

Candidates should be familiar with Native American culture and tribal issues in order to assist the Tribal & Customer Engagement team with any necessary projects.

To be eligible, students must meet the following criteria: currently enrolled in a four-year Bachelor of Engineering degree program at an institution of higher education, or working towards a graduate degree in engineering, have a current Grade Point Average of 2.5 or higher, and possess functional computer skills. Preference will be given to Juniors and Seniors majoring in electrical, civil, mechanical, or environmental engineering.
