
PNM COVID Customer Relief Fund deadline extended

The deadline to apply for the PNM COVID Customer Relief Fund – a financial relief program that helps families, small businesses, and nonprofits struggling to pay their electric bill – has been extended to March 31, 2022. The PNM COVID Customer Relief Fund helps eligible customers pay down, or even pay off, their pastdue PNM bill. The deadline has been extended due to the number of customers that are still experiencing financial hardship from the pandemic.

Between the PNM COVID Customer Relief Fund, the PNM Good Neighbor Fund, the State of New Mexico Emergency Rental Assistance Program, and other financial assistance programs with other agencies, more than 15,000 customers have received assistance towards their past-due PNM bill, totaling more than \$7.9 million dollars of financial assistance given directly to customers in need.

How to receive help from the PNM COVID Customer Relief Fund:

- Gather verification of household income
- A copy of your LIHEAP approval, if applicable
- Copies of identification for all household members
- A copy of your past-due PNM bill

New Pueblo scholarship

A new PNM Pueblo Scholarship Fund has been created to support educational and professional development of pueblo residents in New Mexico. To immediately seed the scholarship fund, \$200,000 has been added along with a \$1 million endowment for the fund. PNM will engage Albuquerque based, American Indian Graduate Center (AIGC) to establish and administer the PNM Pueblo Scholarship endowment fund and plans to award the first round of scholarships for the fall 2022 and spring 2023 semesters.

PNM Meter Reader finds family dog after owner dies in a tragic crash

A vehicle driven by a suspected drunk driver crashed into another vehicle resulting in the death of Kevin Barton of Albuquerque. With Barton were his three dogs, two of which were found on scene, but the third dog, Otis, ran away. A few days later, PNM Meter Reader Samantha Hernandez was reading meters and found the injured dog trembling in a corner behind a commercial building less than a mile from the crash. She worked diligently with the community, and within 30 minutes Otis was reunited with Barton's family. Hernandez gave Barton's family her condolences and said she is thankful she was in the right place at the right time to help reunite Otis with the family and hopefully bring them a little bit of peace after such a tragedy. The Albuquerque Journal recently recognized Hernandez as an auxiliary angel in its annual 'Angels Among Us' awards for unsung heroes that make a positive impact in our community.
