How to Claim Your Incentives

Prescriptive Path

 Submit a rebate application, photo(s) and purchase receipt(s) via the online prescriptive portal.[‡]

Performance (Whole-House) Path

- 1. Select a RESNET-accredited HERS Rater to maximize the performance incentives.
- 2. Build homes according to the measures you have selected.
- 3. Conduct on-site inspections and home performance testing with a HERS Rater.
- 4. Submit supporting documentation for an application via the online performance portal.

Reporting Requirements

- Select home data is required to qualify for incentives. Financial incentives are paid after the program receives and verifies required information.
- The **Prescriptive Path** requires purchase receipts and AHRI Certificates.
- through use of an approved energy-use simulation program and a series of on-site inspections and diagnostic tests.

‡If a home is selected for post-installation quality assurance (QA), the QA verification must be completed before the incentive is paid.

The Performance (Whole-House) Path requires a RESNET-accredited, independent HERS Rater verification
